

ORDINANCE 2022-14

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ZACHARY TO PURCHASE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY AS REQUIRED BY HOME RULE CHARTER §2-09 (A) (12) RELATING TO THE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY ON FLONACHER ROAD AND IN NEAR VICINITY AND PROXIMITY TO THE EXISTING CITY PUBLIC WORKS FACILITIES AND FIRE STATION AND FOR ALL OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO

WHEREAS, The City of Zachary (the “City”) has been informed that a parcel of immovable property within the corporate limits of the City is available for purchase, and

WHEREAS, The City desires to purchase certain immovable property lying within the corporate limits of the City, and believes such purchase is in the best interests of the City, and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the procedural necessity of a specific ordinance required by the City’s Home Rule Charter, specifically §2-09 (A) (12) to acquire same,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Zachary shall purchase certain immovable property lying within the corporate limits of the City and described as Lot D-5-B of the Julius Johnson Estate Subdivision as depicted and more fully described on the attached Exhibit “A” which is made a part hereof.

This Ordinance shall become effective at the expiration of ten (10) calendar days after publication by the City Council for the City of Zachary unless the referenced ordinance shall specify another effective date, all pursuant to § 2-10 (C) of the Home Rule Charter adopted by the electors for the City of Zachary.
